Summer Camp Plans Are In Full Swing– By: Nicole Lucera

With Summer only a couple months away, the Recreation Department has its new Summer Camp plans in full swing and ready to go. Instead of having the traditional half-day program at Ruscitti Park, Recreation Director Matt Veronesi wanted to try something new; something that he is hoping will be more convenient for working parents. This Summer, Ruscitti Park will be home to its first-ever full day program. The camp will be held from 9-4, and include sports, arts & crafts, table games, movies, water games,

special guests, and outside trips. The program is for 6-12 year olds and will be separated by age groups. The fees are \$50 a week or \$210 for six weeks for one child, \$75 a week for two children or \$350 for six weeks, or \$100 a week for 3+ children or \$460 for six weeks. There will also be early drop off (8:00am) and late pick up (5:00pm) available for an additional \$15 per week. There will also be a half-day program which will be held at San Giacomo park for \$2.00 per child for the whole six weeks. This camp will be broken down into a morning session

(6-9 year olds) from 9am-12noon and an afternoon session (10-12 year olds) from 1pm-4pm. Lastly, we will continue to keep our Summer Fun Days program the same as its been in the past and this will be held in the Community Center. This camp is for 3-5 year olds and is \$200, and \$130 for each additional child. There will be a morning session (9-11:30) and an afternoon session (1-3:30pm). **The Recreation Department will be open on Saturday 4/14 from 9-12 to begin taking registration. You MUST bring birth certificates, current utility bill, and child's immunization records.**
