### Summer Camp Registration— Saturday, April 5th. By: Nicole Lucera

The Recreation Department will be open on Saturday, April 5th from 9am-12noon to begin taking registration for all summer camps. In order to register your children, you MUST provide the following documentation: child's birth certificate, current copy of child's immunization records, and a current utility bill. If you do not have all required paperwork, you will NOT be able to register. We will also be taking registration anytime after April 5th at the Recreation office. You must come to the office to register, you will not be able to sign up online.

The summer camps will be as follows: **Full Day Summer Camp**— Ages 6-12

years old. The camp will be held at Ruscitti Park (located behind Recreation Department) and will run from July 7th-August 15th (Monday-Friday) from 9:00am-4:00pm. We will also be providing early drop-off at 8:00am and late pick-up at 5:00pm for an additional \$15 per week per child. The prices are: \$50/week-1 child, \$80/week-2 children, and \$110/week-3 or more children.

**Playground Summer Camp (also known as "half-day camp")**— Ages 6-12 years old. The camp will be held at San Giacomo Park and will run

from July 7th-August 15th (Monday-Friday) from 9:00am-1:00pm. The cost is \$30 per child (for full 6-week program).

**Summer Fun Days**— Ages 3-5 years old. The camp will be held in the Community Center (located below the Ambulance Corps. Behind Town Hall) and will run from July 7th-August 14th (Monday-Thursday). This camp will be broken down into two sessions: Morning session will be 9-11:30am and afternoon session will be 1-3:30pm. The cost is \$210 (\$140 each additional child).
