The Town of New Windsor Recreation Department has begun renting out our fields at Mt. Airy Sports Complex. Right now the only fields available for rental are the soccer fields and the multi purpose football/ soccer field. Eventually the softball fields once completed will also be available to be rented out.

The field rental fee is \$30 an hour without lights, and \$40 an hour if the use of lights is required.

Supervisor Green and the Town Board also approved the request by us to be able

to rent out the Community Center for town residents to have parties or events there. The price to rent the Community center is \$50 an hour with a four hour minimum required. The Community Center is a great building that is perfect for parties or events.

Summer camp sign-ups have been going really well. The full day camp that we have developed has been very popular with our residents, especially working parents. We wanted to give parents an affordable option for summer camps, and I think we achieved that goal. Thank you to Supervisor Green and the Town Board for allowing us to develop the full day

summer camp program. For those residents that liked our half day program, we are still offering it, with one change the location is now San Giacomo Park as opposed to Ruscitti Park.

Summer is right around the corner and we at the Recreation Department are very excited about our upcoming concert series starting on Wednesday June 27th at 7pm.
